

MCI Level C/D Event

This event would be sent by GNYHA to ALL hospitals in the region after a Level C or Level D Mass Casualty Event, as defined by FDNY. The purpose is to retrospectively collect data on incident-related patients, including those who arrived on their own. This would be a separate process than that used by FDNY EMS to notify those hospitals closest to the Mass Casualty Incident.
