Patient Protection Events	Patient suicide, attempted suicide, or self-harm that results in serious injury, while being cared for in a healthcare setting	922

Potential Criminal Events	Death or serious injury of a patient or staff member resulting from a physical assault (i.e., battery) that occurs within or on the grounds of a healthcare setting	921	
Potential Criminal Events	Sexual abuse/assault on a patient or staff member within or on the grounds of a healthcare setting	963	
Product or Device Events	Patient death or serious injury associated with the use or function of a device in patient care, in which the device is used or functions other than as intended	938	
Radiologic Events	Death or serious injury of a patient or staff associated with the introduction of a metallic object into the MRI area	915	MRI
Radiologic Events	Misadministration of radiation or radioactive material (as defined by BERP, Section 16.25, 10 NYCRR)	914
