Free Buprenorphine Waiver Training

For New York City Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Clinical Nurse Specialists, Certified Nurse Midwives, Physician Assistants, and Students (MD, DO, PA, NP)

Background:

Buprenorphine is an effective medication for treatment of opioid use disorder and can be prescribed in office-based primary care settings. Physicians, nurse practitioners, certified nurse midwives, clinical nurse specialists, or physician assistants can prescribe buprenorphine after obtaining a waiver. Physicians are required to complete an 8-hour training in order to apply for a waiver; nurse practitioners and physician assistants must take 24 hours of training (inclusive of the 8-hour training) in order to apply. This course fulfills the 8-hour training requirement.

Training Format:

The half-and-half format will include approximately 4 hours of online training *prior* to 4 hours of in-person training. **Pre-registration by the deadline is required.**
