

To enhance information sharing, GNYHA has arranged with the New York State Department of Health (DOH) to make visible key data elements from the Critical Asset Survey (CAS) in GNYHA’s Sit Stat platform. All New York State hospitals are expected to update the CAS at least semiannually and upon asset changes reported on in the survey. Incorporation of key CAS data elements into Sit Stat will improve data alignment and enhance the completeness of facility data in Sit Stat without additional data entry burdens on facilities.

By completing the [Data Access Form](#), your organization consents to DOH providing the following information from the HERDS CAS to GNYHA for the purpose of GNYHA displaying your organization’s responses within its Sit Stat system.
