

HEALTH WORKFORCE FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

Programs as Recruitment and Retention Tools

One of HRSA's oldest and most well-established health workforce program—National Health Service Corps (NHSC)—targets multiple disciplines and focuses on primary care access in areas of the country most impacted by health profession shortage. NHSC incentivizes primary care providers to practice in the county's most underserved communities in exchange for educational loan repayment. NHSC awardees are individual clinicians, not institutions. However, to qualify for the program, individuals must be employed at HRSA-approved sites. HRSA provides approved sites with advertising materials and institutions can use their status as an approved site to recruit and retain staff and faculty. NHSC sites have access to HRSA's Health Workforce Connector, a platform on which NHSC sites can post open positions and recruit NHSC clinicians. HRSA also will periodically host virtual job fairs for NHSC sites where clinicians from across the country can meet and discuss opportunities.
